The above labor unions are in support of SB 193 by Senator Bill Monning.

SB 193 would require chemical manufacturers, suppliers, and distributors, when requested by the Hazardous Evaluation System and Information Service (HESIS), to provide the names and contact information for customers who have purchased chemicals or products that are part of the HESIS data base.

This bill will insure that, when workers need to be protected from chemical exposure at the workplace, HESIS will have complete data.
